RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ELECTION OF STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES TO ICC

- 1. The Committee re-notified the earlier schedule of election as per the rules of Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)
- 2. The Committee unanimously nominated Dr. Bhaswati Das, CSRD/SSS as Presiding Officer of the Election Committee to ICC.
- 3. As per clause 4.1 (c) vide Resol. No.5.3/EC/18.09.2017 election of three student representatives each from the following three constituencies will be conducted: a. Under Graduate - B.A./B.Tech/ B. Sc.

b. Post Graduate

M.A./ M. Tech/ M.Sc.

c. Research Scholar -

M. Phil./ Ph.D.

Note: Only one candidate from one constituency shall be elected.

- 4. The office bearers of JNUSU/Counsellors shall not be eligible for contesting ICC Election.
- 5. The student member of ICC shall also not be eligible to contest JNUSU elections.
- 6. Out of the three students representative to ICC, at least two are reserved for female candidates. Further, on the basis of rotation, the Committee decided that Masters & Research Scholar constituencies are earmarked for female candidates for the year 2017-2018.
- 7. The term of elected members shall be for one year only.
- 8. Students of respective constituency as mentioned in point no.3 can cast his/her vote to his/her constituency only.
- 9. A student member once elected to ICC shall not be eligible for re-election to ICC.
- 10. The Committee decided the following rules for contesting ICC election.
 - a. Candidates shall submit their nominations in the prescribed format available at Dean of Students Office.
 - b. A student can file nomination only for his/her respective constituency.
 - c. Only a bonafide student of JNU pursuing regular course of study is eligible to contest ICC election.
 - d. Proposer, seconder and the candidate must be from the same constituency.
- 11. Candidates contesting for ICC election shall abide by the rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Presiding Officer and Dean of Students.
- 12. Decisions of the Presiding Officer, Election Committee in all matters pertaining to elections shall be final and binding.
- 13. All students shall carry their valid Identity Cards at the time of casting their votes.
- 14. Voting shall take place at Auditorium II, Convention Centre, JNU from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on 29.09.2017.
- 15. All queries & complaints with respect to ICC election shall be addressed to the Presiding Officer, ICC Election Committee.
- 16. The votes shall be cast by Electronic Voting Machines (EVM) and no postal-ballot papers shall be allowed.
