Systems of domination maintain themselves not merely through force but through patterns of cognition and affect: learning to see and feel about the world in particular ways. Moreover, these patterns are not constant over time, but will evolve to adapt to changing circumstances. In this paper I will look at some of the ways in which white domination perpetuates itself, above all (in recent years) through the cultivation of a certain kind of "ignorance" about history and social reality.
