Applicants may submit their **Bio-data, Caste/Tribe Certificate and** a brief write-up of about 500 words giving their research area. Applications may be sent to Professor Narender Kumar, Coordinator, **Research Methodology Workshop, Centre for Political Studies**, School of Social Sciences, JNU New Delhi. The last date for submitting application is **March 15, 2016**. Decision of the Institute regarding the selection of the candidates shall be final. In case sufficient number of candidates from SC and Other Marginalized Groups are not available, candidates from general category who are working on issues relating to ST/ SC/ other marginalised groups will be considered.

1. No registration fee will be charged from the participants.
2. The selected out of station participants will get free boarding and lodging on twin-sharing basis. Train fare (IIIAC) by the shortest route will be reimburse.
3. A certificate of Participation will be issued to the participants successfully completing the Workshop.
