As a Humboldt Fellow (1998-99, May-July 2000, May 2001, June-July 2003, June 2005), he worked at University of Bonn on the treatise ***Institutionalizing International Environmental Law*** (New York: Transnational Publishers, 2004). Main areas of his current research work include, 'Law-making process in international environmental law', 'international environmental governance', 'legal status of the secretariats of multilateral environmental agreements', 'centralized legalization on sectoral environmental issues as well as 'synergy and inter-linkages' concerning Multilateral Environmental Agreements.
