Dr. Ramesh C. Gaur, presently the University Librarian, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, is a well-known library professional of India. Prior to this he was Librarian and Head, Kala Nidhi Division of Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA), New Delhi and was the Project Coordinator of an International Bibliographic Project known as ABIA, South and Southeast Asian Art and Archeology Index.

A Fulbright Scholar, Dr. Gaur is a science graduate with Ph. D in Library and Information Science. After a rich exposure in corporate sector at Eicher Research Centre, and Brisk Securities Ltd, he joined Institute of Management Technology, Ghaziabad where his first major task, hailed by all concerned, was of automating its library and transforming it into a state-of-the-art establishment. This feat he replicated at the famed Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR), Mumbai and also at Management Development Institute (MDI), Gurgaon. He has also worked at Central Road Research Institute (CRRI-CSIR) and Research and Information System for Non-aligned and other Developing Countries (RIS), New Delhi.

A young and dynamic professional, Dr Gaur has shared his expertise with many National and International Committees, Bodies and Groups Such as IFLA, NDLTD, UNESCO, UGC etc of which he is member/advisor. Dr. Gaur has visited USA, Russia, Germany, Japan, Thailand, Indonesia, Cambodia, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Malaysia, Singapore, Hong Kong and the Netherlands to pursue his various professional assignments related to Digital Library and allied fields.

He has widely traveled in India to participate in various professional meetings and to deliver invited talks. In 22 years of professional career, he has published over 50 papers, delivered over 150 lectures, authored/edited four important books in his chosen field, and sponsored/supported organizations related to library and information science. His engagements and achievements in the service of the profession are too numerous to be counted here. This prolific writer has already been decorated with many awards and honours.
