

JNU Approaches UGC for Releasing Funds

Several students of JNU have not received the non-Net fellowships for last few months, since the UGC has not released about Rs. 11 crores of rupees to JNU that is overdue. The Vice Chancellor has held several rounds of discussions with the top officials of the UGC to address this issue. The goal is to resolve the current financial problem of the University at the earliest, since the current situation has severely affected a large number of students and also has adversely affected the normal functioning of the university.

It is expected that the UGC takes up this issue on a priority basis and considers releasing the outstanding amount immediately to alleviate the heightened financial hardship of the students and to enable JNU to meet several essential expenditures for the optimum functioning of the University.

In the meantime Inter-Hostel Administration of the University has permitted the non-Net fellowship holders, particularly those facing financial problem, to continue to have their mess facilities. Other defaulters have been asked to make the payment of their mess dues in time.
