

- i) The student was ill and was hospitalized/advised complete bed rest for a major part of the semester/year, especially the latter half of the semester (s) including end semester examination period and not just visiting OPD of hospitals or Health Centre of JNU occasionally.
- ii) The certificate produced by the student is from a Govt. Hospital or a hospital recognized by the Govt./JNU.
- iii) A resident student falling sick should immediately report the matter to the Health Centre of the University, the Hostel Warden and the Chairperson of the Centre/Dean of the School, even if he/she chooses to undergo treatment elsewhere, including places outside Delhi. If treatment was undergone elsewhere, he/she should, on return, produce all the medical documents to the Health Centre.
- iv) Day scholars who fall sick and undergo treatment elsewhere should always keep the Chairperson of the Centre and Dean of the School informed of their illness and the treatment they are undergoing and produce medical documents to the Centre/School on resuming studies.
- v) A student is awarded foreign scholarship/fellowship which he/she would like to avail of during the semester(s).
