

Syllabus Guidelines for MPhil/PhD Entrance Examination of CITD, SIS

The written test for admission to MPhil/PhD program of the Centre for International Trade and Development would comprise of questions on the courses in standard MA Economics programme, specifically (1) Micro Economics, (2) Macro Economics, (3) Mathematics, (4) International Trade, (5) Economic Development, (6) Statistics and Econometrics, and related disciplines such as game theory, environmental economics, public economics, banking and finance, etc. There would also be questions on research methodologies comprising of methodologies in Mathematical Economics, Statistics, Econometrics, and tools of Applied Microeconomics and Applied Macroeconomics.

Pattern of MPhil Entrance Examination Question Paper

Following the UGC notification 2016, the MPhil/PhD Entrance Examination question paper for the coming JNUEE-2017-18 will have two sections

- 1) Section A with questions on research methodology (50%)
- 2) Section B with subject-specific questions (50%)

In Section A, research methodology questions would pertain to methods and tools utilized for MPhil/PhD in Economics at CITD. These would include methodologies in Mathematical Economics, Statistics, Econometrics, and Tools of Applied Microeconomics and Applied Macroeconomics.

In Section B of the Entrance Examination, the subject-specific questions would pertain to Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Econometrics, Development Economics, International Trade, and Public Economics.
