There is a misinformation campaign that JNU is imposing Hindi on students. This is to underline that there is no such policy followed in JNU.

However, as per decision of the statutory bodies of the University (Academic Council meeting held on 19/3/2017 and 30/10/2012, and Executive Council meeting held on 20/11/2012), bilingual degree certificates in Hindi and English are issued.

Since the fields in the bilingual degree certificate format need to be printed in Hindi and English, the students are asked to write their names and titles in Roman (English) and Devnagri (Hindi) scripts, the transliteration of the English version of dissertation/thesis, so that their names and title can be spelled accurately on the degree certificate. Moreover, we have asked the staffs deputed at various Centres/Schools to extend their help to the students who do not know Hindi.
