


## Connecting to the JNU Secure Wireless Network with an Android Phone or Tablet

1. First, go to the Home Screen on your Android Device, and click on “Wi-Fi”. (If it is not showing, then pull down the top menu until you see it.) Once open, select the wireless connection called “JNU Academic”, “JNU Campus”, “JNU Residence”



2. Next, type or select the following from the drop-down menus:

- Under “**EAP method**”, select “**PEAP**”.
- Under “**Phase 2 authentication**”, select “**MSCHAPV2**”
- Under “**CA certificate**”, select “**Use system certificates**”
- Online certificate “**Don’t validate**”
- Under “**Domain**” type “**jnu.ac.in**”
- Under “**Identity**”, type your username. (Provided by the CIS)
- Under “**Anonymous Identity**” type your username.
- Under “**Password**”, type your password.



Once done, click “Connect”, and your device will now be connected to the JNU Secure Wireless Network.
