SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT AND FULL PAPER

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT

- ❖ The abstract should be a concise note of not more than 500 words in coherence with the broader theme of the conference. It can be based on one or more than one subthemesof the conference.
- ❖ It must contain a clearly defined research objective/hypothesis, research methodology as well as the major findings of the research.
- ❖ In case any references are made to a previously conducted study/research, then it should be mentioned in the footnotes.
- ❖ The abstract should have at least 5 keywords.
- ❖ The abstract must be an original work of the author(s).

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR FULL PAPER

- ❖ The full paper must not be more than 8000 words (excluding references).
- ❖ The paper must have clearly written out sections in conformity with academic style of writing, i.e., introduction, literature review, research objectives, research questions, research methodology, observations, analysis, conclusions and bibliography.
- ❖ The paper should have footnotes to references made in the text instead of endnotes.
- ❖ Any references made in the paper to a previously conducted study/research, must be properly cited in the APA format.

(APA format – Author's Last Name, First Initial. (Year). Article title. Magazine/Journal/Newspaper Title, Volume Number (Issue Number), Page Number.)
