- Abstract: 150-200 words.
- Manuscript: 3,000-6,000 words.
- Citation: Harvard system of reference (Name, year of publication).
- Bibliography: Add a full bibliography of the works cited at the end of your paper.
- Author: Full names and institutional addresses of authors should appear on a separate cover-page only
