Online applications are invited in the prescribed Application Format from eligible candidates for appointment to the post of Librarian, Controller of Examinations and Superintendent Engineer on tenure/deputation basis for a period of 5 years.

Mode of Recruitment:

By deputation or appointment on tenure basis for a period of five years or till attaining the age of superannuation i.e., 62 years whichever is earlier.

Essential Qualification & Experience:

Officer/Academician from Central/ State Govt. Universities or autonomous organizations possessing qualifications & experience as below :-

1. Master's Degree in Library Science/ Information Science/Documentation Science with at least 55% of marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed.
2. At least 10 years as a Librarian at any level in University Library or ten years of teaching as Assistant/ Associate Professor in Library Science or ten years experience as a College Librarian.
3. Evidence of innovative Library services, including the integration of ICT in a library.
4. A Ph.D. Degree in Library Science/Information Science/Documentation/ Archives and Manuscript keeping.

Note: The appointment shall be made on tenure/deputation basis for a period of 5 years which can be renewed for similar term by the Executive Council of the University.

Mode of Recruitment:

On tenure/deputation basis for a term of 05 years or his/her attaining the age of 62 years or attaining the age of superannuation in his/her parent office whichever is earlier.

Essential Qualification & Experience:

- (a) Master's degree with at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed.
- (b) At least 15 years of experience as Assistant Professor in the Academic Level-11 and above or with 8 years of service in the Academic Level-12 and above including as Associate Professor along with experience in educational administration,
OR
- (c) Comparable experience in research establishment and/ or other institutions of higher education,
OR
- (d) 15 years of administrative experience, of which 8 years shall be as Deputy Registrar or an equivalent post.

Note: The appointment shall be made on tenure/deputation basis for a period of 5 years which can be renewed for similar term by the Executive Council of the University.

Mode of Recruitment:

By deputation or appointment on tenure basis for a period of five years or till attaining the age of superannuation, i.e., 60 years, whichever is earlier.

Essential Qualification & Experience:

B.E./B.Tech. in Civil or Electrical Engineering from a recognized Institution with 55% marks, with at least ten years of regular service as Executive Engineer or equivalent in Pay Level-11 or above in Central/State Governments/ Autonomous Bodies/ Statutory Organizations/ PSUs/ Universities or recognized Research/Higher Educational Institutions.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. There shall be no upper age limit for regular employees of the Jawaharlal Nehru University subject to the condition that they have rendered at least three years of regular service on the closing date for submission of the application for direct recruitment.
2. 5% relaxation in percentage of marks at Bachelor's/ Master's level from 55% to 50% will be extended to SC/ST/PwD categories and to the existing incumbents who are already in the University system as provided under UGC guidelines issued from time to time.
3. Persons already in Govt. Service/Autonomous bodies/ Universities/ PSU should apply through proper channel along with vigilance clearance and integrity certificate, failing which their application will not be entertained. Attested copies of ACRs/APARs of last five years be also sent separately. After submission of online applications, the print out of the same is to be forwarded through the employer along with the Annual Performance Appraisal Reports (APARs)/ACRs for the preceding five years upto 2025, Vigilance Clearance Certificate duly certified by the Competent Authority and NOC to the **Assistant Registrar (Recruitment), Room No. 131**, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi-110067 by 12th October 2026.
4. Merely possessing the prescribed qualifications and requisite experience would not entitle a person to be called for the interview.
5. The candidates holding the same position in Central/State Universities in same pay level will be preferred.
6. The University reserves the right:
 - (a) to fix criteria for screening the applications so as to reduce the number of candidates to be called for interview;
 - (b) the selection will be made on the basis of performance in the interview on the recommendation of the Selection Committee;
 - (c) to relax any of the conditions of age/ qualifications/ experience at its discretion; and;
 - (d) not to fill up the advertised position.
7. The candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non creamy layer)/PwD categories are required to submit their respective caste/disability certificate in the format prescribed by the Govt. of India. Candidates belonging to PwD category should meet the prescribed criteria of physical handicapness as applicable in the Govt. of India rules for respective PwD category. The OBC (non creamy layer) certificate should be submitted in the DoPT/ Central Government prescribed format only. The University reserves the right to verify the certificates, before the interview/ joining etc., and to summarily cancel/terminate the cases, if the certificates are found false.
8. Knowledge of Computer application is necessary for the post.
9. Application fee of Rs.1000/- shall be payable online through payment gateway. No applications fee is payable in respect of SC/ST/PwD and women applicants.
10. Incomplete applications shall liable to be rejected.
11. Online application link is available in the University website i.e. <https://jnu.ac.in/career> under 'Non-Teaching' tab.

12. Those who are applying for the post should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility criteria as stipulated in the Advertisement. If it is found at any stage that they do not fulfil the stipulated criteria, the candidature will be cancelled.
13. Canvassing or bringing influence in any form shall disqualify candidature of the applicant without notice.
14. The upper age limit for the post advertised shall be determined as on closing date of advertisement.
15. Consequent upon adoption of self-certification provisions as required by the Government of India, the University shall process the applications entirely on the basis of information/documents submitted by the candidates duly self-attested. In case the information/documents are found to be false/ incorrect by way of commission or omission, the sole responsibility and liability shall be of the candidate.
16. Candidate called for interview should report along with all testimonials/certificates in original along with photo ID. They should carry an additional set of copy of these testimonials/certificates for being deposited with the University at the time of interview.
17. The eligibility of the candidate(s) will be determined on the basis of qualifications/experiences etc. acquired by them up to the last date fixed for receipt of online application.
18. Candidates should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered, fabricated or suppress any material / information while submitting the application and self-certified copies/ testimonials.
19. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to ascertain his/her own eligibility for the post for which he/she is applying in accordance with the prescribed qualifications, experience etc., and submit his/her online application duly filled-in, along with the desired information and documents as per the advertisement. Suppression of factual information, supply of fake documents, providing false or misleading information or canvassing in any manner on the part of the candidate shall lead to his/her disqualification. In case, it is detected at any point of time in future, even after appointment, that the candidate was not eligible, his/her appointment shall be liable to termination forthwith as per this clause.
20. Acceptance of documents submitted by an applicant shall be subject to verification by the competent authority at any point of time even after joining the employment. If any document is found to be false/fake/incorrect either before or after appointment, the document shall be summarily rejected or action may be initiated against the candidate which shall lead to cancellation of his/her appointment, as the case may be.
21. The person appointed against any post shall be governed by the Act/Statutes/Ordinances/Rules of the University and also the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, CCS (CCA) Rule, 1965 or any other rules of the Government of India, as amended from time to time and any other rule/resolution prescribed specifically for maintaining the conduct of the employees by the Executive Council of the University.
22. The selected candidates shall produce a medical fitness certificate from the Medical Board of a Govt. Hospital prior to his joining. However, the candidates already serving in any Government service/Autonomous Bodies /PSUs/ Central/ State Universities etc. having already submitted medical fitness certificate at the time of their initial appointment, in such cases the production of such medical certificates shall not be required again.
23. The terms and conditions of appointment shall be communicated in the 'offer of appointment' to the selected candidates. If the candidate does not accept the terms and conditions mentioned in the offer of appointment within the stipulated time, the offer shall be treated as withdrawn.
24. The selected candidates shall be required to perform duties as per the rules of the University, as amended from time to time. The University shall be free to assign any duty as per the exigency of the situation at any time even during non-working hours/holidays which the employee shall have to perform without fail to avoid any disciplinary action.
25. The University may draw a reserved panel to fill up a post. In case a candidate on higher merit regrets to join within a period specified by the University or repatriated to his/her parent organization, for whatsoever the reasons, within a year, the offer shall be made to the next candidate in the merit list, if otherwise in order.
26. The applicants who had already applied pursuant to Advertisement No. 01/RC (NT)/2024 dated 30.11.2024 (for the post of Librarian) and Advertisement No. 01/RC (NT)/2025 dated 26.07.2025 (for the post of Controller of Examinations) such candidates shall not be required to apply afresh, their candidature shall remain valid, subject to their fulfilling the prescribed eligibility condition under the fresh advertisement.
27. The University shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted by a candidate at the time of appointment or during the tenure of the service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted by

- the candidates are false the candidate has suppressed relevant information, then his/her services shall be terminated without prejudice to any other action initiated by the University.
28. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the University reserves right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate.
 29. The deputation shall be governed by the terms & conditions as notified by the Govt. of India from time to time.
 30. All applicable relaxations in respect of the notified posts shall be given to the candidates as per the Government of India rules/provisions issued from time to time.
 31. No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates called for interview.
 32. No correspondence or personal enquiries shall be entertained by the University.
 33. Crucial date for fixing eligibility criteria, upper age limit, etc. shall be the last date of submission of applications.
 34. Eligible and interested candidates may apply online through the University website <https://www.jnu.ac.in/career>. Applications through any mode other than online will not be accepted. Applicants shall submit online applications by uploading a current photograph, signature, copies of essential qualifications, experience, date of birth, caste/PwD certificate, NOC from the present employer, APAR, and other required documents. Those already in Government/Autonomous Body/PSU service should submit the application through proper channel. Candidates who do not submit the NOC while applying online are required to submit the same before appearing in the interview. The last date to submit online applications, complete in all respects, is **05th October 2026 (05:00 PM)**.

Crucial date for fixing eligibility criteria, upper age limit, etc. shall be the last date of submission of applications.
