This is brought to the kind notice and information to all the concerned stakeholders with reference to the Notification No. JNU/IHA/ 77 (A) dated 4th April 2025 regarding handing over of newly constructed Barak Hostel to JNU, New Delhi funded by North East Council (NEC) MoDONER, Govt. of India. The Barak hostel was opened officially for allotment of the JNU Students on 7th April, 2025.

The Hostel allotment process started from 8th April, 2025 in phased manner (the first list of the girls is available on IHA, JNU website) wherein priority have been given to the North East Student in Barak Hostel. Presently all JNU North Eastern students are residing in all JNU hostels. No hostel is reserved on the basis of specific region or culture in JNU.

The JNU is a Central University which promotes and maintains social integrity, multiculturalism, inclusivity and diversity in the campus. As per hostel manual of IHA, JNU, one of the objectives of the hostel life is "to ensure that students coming from different parts of the country learn to live together and strengthen their relations with mutual cooperation and goodwill".

As per the OFFICE MEMORANDUM of Govt. of India, Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (NEC /8/ 2023-UNDER SECRETARY (A) dated 10.10.2023 clearly mentioned in the Record Discussion on the Project Barak Hostel JNU Campus New Delhi held on 10.10.2023 POINT 5 (VII) that "the facility created should be put to use by JNU without delay and priority shall be given to North East Students". Accordingly, the priority will be given to North-East students in allotment of Barak Hostel.

It is underlined that JNU is following its policy for hostel allotment and the same matrix of allotment will be followed for Barak Hostel.
