

### **INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS**

- 1. Anti-Plagiarism/AI: The editorial board may reject the submitted article, if it is found plagiarised/AI generated text.
- 2. Word Limit: Articles should not exceed 3000 words excluding bibliography & notes.
- 3. **Abstract:** An Abstract of the article (upto 200 words) should be submitted in English and Russian. Five keywords to be provided along with the abstract.
- 4. **Biography of Author (s):** The biography of author in English (upto 200 words) should be given at the end of the paper.
- 5. **Word Format:** Only Word format of the article is to be sent. The pdf files will not be considered.
- 6. Proofread: The manuscript should be fully proofread throughout by the author.
- 7. **Illustrations:** Images, tables, etc. should be embedded into the manuscript. All the illustrations should be properly named/indexed.
- 8. Format: Article should be submitted in MS Word only Format of the text: Times New Roman, 12 point font, single space, normal intent. Page margin: Left 2, Right 1, Top 1, Bottom 1 Title of the article: Times New Roman, 12 point font, bold, capital letters, single space, heading intent Name of Author/ Co-Author: Times New Roman, 10 point font, bold, single space, normal intent followed by bibliographical information of the author in not more than 50 words along with contact number and e-mail ID.
- 9. **References:** The authors are requested to mention the references in MLA format. Footnotes are not accepted.
