About the Conference

Today 72% of the India's population live in Rural areas and include the majority of the India's poor lived in these rural areas. They are constrained by a lack of productive employment opportunities, poor education and infrastructure, and limited access to markets and services. As the complexities of rural life grow, communities and local leaders are at the forefront of finding sustainable solutions to poverty and inadequate housing, hunger and health, clean water, energy, environmental degradation and climate change, infrastructure, transport, education, migration, violence, and gender equality. These and other challenges are interconnected with similar issues in rural areas and municipalities of all size.

This Conference will discusse the need to address rural development as a necessary condition for achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). This session also will launch "A New Inclusive and Sustainable social Innovation for Rural Integration Paradigm for the 21st Century. A discussion about the aims and objectivise of Start-up village Entrepreneurship programme.
