This fast-paced interaction mirrors the span of an elevator ride, emphasizing the importance of delivering a compelling and concise narrative.

Startup Idea Pitch Written Summary Format:

- 1. Company Name:
- 2. Brief Idea Summary:
 - Business Concept and Model: Outline your product or service, revenue generation strategy, and plans for profitability.
 - Market / Customers: Define your target market, highlight customer problems you aim to solve, and the potential impact.
 - **Competitive Advantage / Differentiation:** Articulate how your idea differentiates itself from competitors and its market relevance.

Creating the "Startup Idea Pitch" - Six Key Questions:

1. Product or Service: Concisely introduce your offering without diving into intricate details.

2. Market: Identify your target audience and provide insights into the market size and potential.

3. Revenue Model: Describe how you intend to generate revenue and sustain profitability.

4. Company Team: Introduce your team's background, achievements, and your role in the venture.

5. Competition: Briefly present your competition, their accomplishments, and your insights on their strategies.

6. Competitive Advantage: Explain what sets your company apart and why you have a competitive edge.

The PPT of the "Startup Idea Pitch" should have **no more than 6 slides** and the pitching should be as brief as possible.
