Special language and math requirements: School of Business and Economics Undergraduate students are required to demonstrate proficiency in German at the B2 level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) or English at the C1 level. Alternatively the online C-Test should score at least 61 points. Applicants with 50-60 points can apply for a German intensive course prior to the start of the semester.

Graduate students need to be comfortable in English at C1 level or higher. The teaching language of all master programs is English.

The courses at the School of Business and Economics have a strong emphasis on imparting rigorous and quantitative methods of economic analysis and management science. Make sure that you possess a strong background in Mathematics.

Special language requirements: Faculty of Language, Literature and Humanities / Department of English and American Studies

Undergraduate students need to be comfortable in English at B2 level or higher.

Graduate students need to be comfortable in English at C1 level or higher.
