1.	2300061069	Criteria 2: Candidate has claimed 13 publications. Out of which, 9 cannot be considered as they are mere 'reports', and NOT research articles, in 'year in review' contributions to the Yearbook of International Environmental Law. Candidate does not meet Criteria 2 and 4.
2.	2300059806	After reviewing, Criteria 2: Candidate has claimed 7publications. Out of which 1 cannot be considered (Publication No. 2) as it is not a research paper (it has no footnotes). Note: Proof of Publications Nos. 1 & 7 is not provided. Candidate does not meet Criteria 2 and 4.
3.	2300060550	After reviewing, Criteria 1: Candidate has claimed 55% in LL.M. The actual score cannot be calculated because the candidate has not submitted full marksheet. However, the actual score was calculated as 54.6% as per the assessment made in the light of the documents submitted vide Notification RC/67/2023. Candidate does not meet Criteria 1
4.	2300060738	After reviewing, Criteria 2: Candidate has claimed 8 publications. Publications do not focus on issues pertaining to the required specialisation, that is, 'Law of International Organizations'. Publications Nos. 6 & 8 are brief papers of 4-5 pages. Candidate does not meet Criteria 2 and 4.
5.	2300061151	Criteria 2: The candidate has claimed 11 publications. Out of which 5 (publication Nos. 1,2,3,5 &8) are rejected because they are in paid journals whose credentials are suspicious. Publications are on domestic legal issues, not on international law. Candidate does not meet Criteria 2 and 4.
6.	2300053314	After reviewing, Criteria 2: Candidate has claimed 10publications. Out of which 4cannot be considered as they are in paid journal, during a single year (2018) and NOT on International Law. They are shown to be published in completely different discipline: "Pure and Applied Mathematics" and it is prima facie fraudulent: (1). Publication No.3 (honor killing in India); (2) No. 6 (enforced disappearance); (3) No. 9 (national security). Moreover, Publication No. 8 is a brief commentary/opinion piece without footnotes in Mainstream Weekly. Criteria (3): Candidate has claimed 11 Yrs, 8 M experience. Asian African Legal Consultative Organization (AALCO) duration of 5 Yrs, 5 M cannot be considered as is neither teaching nor research institution as required for the post. Candidate does not meet Criteria 2, 3 and 4.

7.	2300059596	<p>Criteria 2: Candidate has not filled this part of the application and not provided details and proof of publications.</p> <p>Criteria 3: Candidate has claimed teaching/research experience for only 7 Yrs, 6 M, which is short of the minimum required for the post.</p> <p>Candidate does not meet Criteria 2, 3 and 4.</p>
8.	2300061189	<p>Criteria 2: Candidate has claimed 9 articles, out of which one is a book review. Out of the remaining 8, there is no publication in 'journals of international repute the field of International Law'. Publications do not focus on issues pertaining to the required specialisation, that is, 'Law of International Organizations'.</p> <p>Candidate does not meet Criteria 2 and 4.</p>
9.	2300060350	<p>Criteria 2: Candidate has claimed 10 articles out of which 6 cannot be considered. Publication Nos. 1, 2, & 3 are published in 2023 in generic journals by the same publisher, namely—Skyalark Publishers, Varanasi; Publication 7 on Copyright vis-a-vis music is in 'Swar Sindhu: National Peer-Reviewed/Refereed Journal of Music', this journal is unrelated to International Law. Publications 9&10 are brief writings that describes legal provisions mostly a reproduction/description of legal provisions. All publications mainly focus on domestic legal issues, NOT International Law.</p> <p>Candidate does not meet criteria 2 and 4.</p>
10.	2300061178	<p>After reviewing, Criteria 2: Candidate has claimed 9 publications. Out of which 4 cannot be considered as they are merely compiled reports 'year in review' Annual Survey of Indian Law and not on International Law issues.</p> <p>Candidate does not meet Criteria 2 and 4.</p>
11.	2300061117	<p>Criteria 2: Candidate has not filled this part of the form and not provided details and proof.</p> <p>Criteria 3: candidate has not filled this part of the form and not provided details and proof.</p> <p>Candidate does not meet Criteria 2, 3 and 4.</p>
12.	2300053895	<p>Criteria 2: Candidate has claimed 8 publications. Out which 5 cannot be considered (Publications No. 3,5,6, 7 & 8) because they are in paid journals whose credentials are suspicious. Publications are on domestic legal issues, NOT on International Law.</p> <p>Candidate does not meet Criteria 2 and 4.</p>
