Yet another Appeal to agitating students to vacate the illegal occupation of Administrative building

The student agitation has moved from a highly objectionable one to a ridiculous one. The Blockaders of the Administration Building, under the leadership of "Committee of Suspended Students", has expressed their willingness through a pamphlet to selectively allow some employees to enter the building to work for only two days. The anarchy created by these students is amply reflected in the very title of their pamphlet that reads: "**Important Notice**" and signed as "Committee of Suspended Students." They want to decide how many days they would allow how many employees, to the complete exclusion of Vice Chancellor, Rectors and Registrar, to work in the administration building. This laughable pamphlet is condemnable, also because they have been spreading lies that the administration building is open, but the VC and other officers are not coming for work. Others have falsely claimed that employees are allowed to enter the building.

The JNUTA is yet to oppose the occupation and blockade of the administration building, while the JNUTA President claims that her emails to the Vice Chancellor have not been responded. This is a ludicrous claim since several teachers and students have been able to meet the VC to complain against the occupation/blockade, but JNUTA representatives find it difficult to do so!
