OFFICE ORDER

In continuation to the Government of NCT of Delhi, Delhi Disaster Management Authority Orders no. F.60/DDMA/COVI-19/2021/466 dated 15.09.2021, No. F.1 (589)/DDMA (HQ)/Misc. matter/COVID/474 dated 30.09.2021, regarding the re-opening of educational institutes with maximum 50% of the seating capacity subject to strict compliance of SOPs notified by DDMA. The University has decided phase-05, 06, 07 & 08 reopening of the campus.

1. Phase-05 of Reopening of JNU from 06-10-2021:

- (a) All Second Year Ph.D. research scholars (both hostellers and day-scholars) are allowed to enter into the campus.
- (b) B. Tech. Third Year and Second Year (both hostellers and day-scholars) are allowed to enter into the campus
- (c) B.Sc-M.Sc. Integrated Ayurveda Biology Second Year students are allowed to enter into the campus.

2. Phase-06 of Reopening of JNU from 12-10-2021: M.A. Final Year Students of SIS, SSIS, SAA and SCDR are allowed to enter into the campus.

3. Phase-07 of Reopening of JNU from 18-10-2021: M.A. Final Year Students of SLL&CS are allowed to enter into the campus.

4. Phase-08 of Reopening of JNU from 25-10-2021: M.A. Final Year Students of SSS are allowed to enter into the campus.

5. The classes (except laboratory practicals) will continue to be in online mode.

6. All teachers may continue to use their offices for taking online classes and carrying out the research activities.

7. Covid-appropriate behaviors should be followed all the time.

Any person found violating the aforesaid instructions, shall be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, Section 188 of IPC and other applicable laws.
